FREE PICKLEBALL LESSONS!



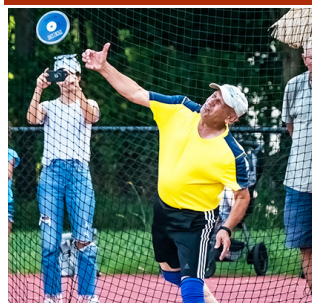

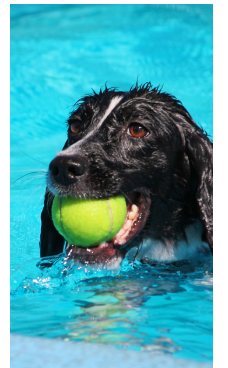
