BALCONY AUDIT

Remember that the following decorations are not permitted on WAL balconies:

- Bird feeders
- Aerials or antennas (unless approved satellite dishes)
- Clothing for airing or drying
- Items or furnishings that may be easily dislodged from the balcony
- Decals, mirrors, and storage items exceeding the height of the balcony
- Bicycles, tricycles, other recreational wheeled vehicles, and vehicle tires
- Rugs and floor coverings

Patrol Services began conducting Balcony Audits on 10/17 to ensure all WAL residents comply with this rule.
