### Voting by Mail

- **Application deadline:** 10/27 at 5 p.m. Apply online at [vote.elections.virginia.gov](http://vote.elections.virginia.gov) or the City's Elections webpage.

### Ballot Drop Boxes

- Available at all polling places on 11/7 from 6 a.m. - 7 p.m. Secure drop box available 24/7 at the Office of Voter Registration & Elections.

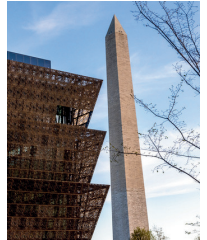
