## RACQUET CLUB UPDATES



There will be no Racquet Sports contracts until the fall. This is due to Racquet Club renovations that are now scheduled to begin in mid-July. Once renovations begin, the Racquet Club will close for up to 30 days. After July 1 and throughout the summer, reservations for racquet sports on the outdoor courts and in the Racquet Club through mid-July can be made through CourtReserve. The Racquet Club will remain open until renovations begin.

## POOL CLOSURE POLICY

According to the National Lightning Safety Institute, at the first sound of thunder or sighting of lightning, all persons will be cleared from the pool and remain clear for at least 30 minutes. If thunder or lightning persists, the pool will remain closed for 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder or sighting of lightning. However, an additional



factor to consider is whether or not the sky is dark and threatening. Unless evident signs of clearing exists, do not consider the storm "ended". The pool will reopen when evidence of clearing is present and danger from lightning no longer exists. During times that the pool is closed for weather-related issues, all patrons will be asked to leave the facility until it is reopened. This applies to the Outdoor and Indoor Pools.

## DON'T FEED THE PROBLEM

While some might love the birds, squirrels, bunnies and other critters who live and visit WAL, however, a problem has arisen with some feeding these animals. When food is left for wildlife to consume, WAL pets can be greatly impacted by this action. Feeding wildlife animals can inadvertently attract pets as well as stray and feral cats. Leftovers can leave pets exposed to potential health hazards. Please do not feed or leave food on the ground, sidewalks, grassy areas, etc.

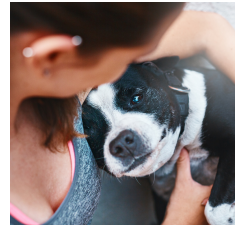
