

You still have an opportunity to cast your vote at the Annual Meeting on Monday, March 6 at 7:00 p.m. in the Community Center. It's important for the Association to achieve a quorum (25% of the unit owners' votes) so we don't have to conduct a second, expensive election. So **PLEASE VOTE!**

I hope you read last month's Wheel and noticed the recognition of Watergate's Employees: promotions, new staff members, years of service, departmental awards, and others. Watergate is fortunate to have so many of our staff with such a long employment history and institutional memory – one even with 40 years! We are also grateful for our newest employees who demonstrating already are their professionalism and potential. On behalf of the Association, *Thank you for your hard work* and dedication!





In addition to preparing for the Annual Meeting, WAL has been busy with many other projects and activities. I highlight the following.

- *FY2022 Audit* Board approved the FY2022 Audit as presented; Watergate is financially sound.
- Funds Transfer- Board transferred \$913,273 of the Association's audited
 FY2022 "Unappropriated equity balance" (unspent year-end funds) to Replacement Reserves.
- Outdoor Courts Renovation Project Board approved a contract to renovate the outdoor courts for \$1,172,155; projected start date is late summer and completion in early fall.
- *Retaining Wall Replacement* The project in the vicinity of buildings 3&4 began in early January and was completed in late February. Please take a look at it!

Large mixing bowl

Streusel topping Ingredients

- 3/4 cup (3³/₄oz) all-purpose flour
- 1/4 cup (³/₄oz) rolled oats
- 1/2 cup (4oz) sugar
- 1/16 teaspoon salt
- 6 tablespoons (3oz) butter

For the Streusel topping:

 In the bowl, combine the flour, oats, sugar, and salt. Rub in the cold butter until fully incorporated, and you've reached the texture of coarse breadcrumbs. Set aside in the fridge while you make the cake. For the Cake:

- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 3 tablespoons milk
- 3 granny smith apples (peeled and sliced thin)

VICTIMS OF COMMUNISM MUSEUM TRIP

The Arts & Entertainment Committee sponsored a February shuttle trip to the Victims of Communism Museum in Washington, DC. The museum just recently opened. Fundraising began in the 1980s, and the VOA (Voice of America) was instrumental in the vision and fundraising for the museum. Refugees from Eastern Europe and the Soviet Union, who were victims of Communism, promoted the need for the museum. Some comments from people who went on the shuttle trip were:

The exhibitions were set up in rooms throughout two floors. There are short videos to watch and things to read in each room – so the learning never stops. This museum features a self-guided tour, and it is located near McPherson Square. The Museum is open Tuesday through Saturday from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM.



The Victims of Communism Museum was the February destination of the A&E Committee.

The entrance to the building is not handicap accessible, but inside, there is an elevator to get to the second floor. Most guests spend 45-minutes touring the exhibits in the museum. Tickets are free and reservations are made online. Donations are graciously accepted online.

BLOSSOMS OF THE SEASON

With every petal that falls to the ground, a memory of their beauty is forever found. Amid the winds of spring, cherry blossoms bloom with their sweet perfume. I was recently informed that there is truly nothing more symbolic of springtime at Watergate than cherry blossoms! As spring approaches, one of the most breathtaking sights in the area is the blooming of the cherry blossoms. These delicate pink and white flowers, which typically bloom for only a few weeks in late March and early April, draw millions of visitors to the Washington, DC area each year. But what is the history behind these iconic trees?

The story of the cherry blossoms in Washington, DC, began in 1912 when the mayor of Tokyo gifted 3,000 cherry blossom trees to the United States as a symbol of friendship between the two nations.

First Lady Helen Taft and the wife of the Japanese ambassador planted the first two trees along the Tidal Basin in a special ceremony. Over the years, more trees were added, and the annual National Cherry Blossom Festival was established in 1935.

Today, there are more than 3,700 cherry blossom trees in the DMV including around East Potomac Park, on the National Mall and even right here at Watergate at Landmark. These trees not only provide a stunning visual display but also have significant cultural and historical importance.


