POLICY RESOLUTION NO. 10

**EDITORIAL POLICY FOR THE PUBLICATIONS
OF THE WATERGATE AT LANDMARK CONDOMINIUM
UNIT OWNERS ASSOCIATION**

**December 16, 1997
(Readopted)**

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Watergate at Landmark Condominium Unit Owners Association that the Association shall publish an official periodical and such other publications as are necessary in the judgment of the Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed important that the preservation of the lifestyle and investment of the owners of Watergate at Landmark be maintained, fostered and protected through effective and proper appropriate communication;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the editorial policy of the Watergate at Landmark publications shall consist of the following tenets, and all persons concerned with the preparation and production of Association publications shall adhere to each principle under all circumstances:

1. Contents of the publications shall conform to the condominium documents and to the established policies of the Board of Directors. The President of the Association or a Board Member-Designee shall review all copy for accuracy of information prior to publication.

2. The official periodical shall be issued on a monthly basis; other publications shall be distributed as required.

3. The purposes of Watergate at Landmark publications are:
(a) to inform residents, **POTENTIAL RESIDENTS AND OWNERS** of matters and developments of significant interest and/or concern to them; (b) to disseminate information regarding the Watergate at Landmark community activities and functions; and (c) to provide a forum for expressing legitimate concerns of the Watergate at Landmark Condominium Unit Owners Association.

4. Priority of publication shall be given to items of significance and interest to the Community pending final approval of the President or the designated representative of the Board of Directors.

5. All reporting shall be fair, objective and in keeping with high standards of journalistic ethics; all information submitted shall be verified for accuracy.
