#### **Email**

Scan or take electronic photos of the required documents. Then email the Unit Profile Sheet and supporting documents to reregistration@watergateatlandmark.com.

#### Physical Drop Location at Resident Services

Place the signed Unit Profile Sheet with corrections and copies of supporting documents in the return envelope provided. Put it in the Gold Mail Slot on the left side of the Resident Services office window under the granite ledge. A copy machine is available for you to scan documents as well.


#### Bldg. Lobby Drop Box (January and March Only)
