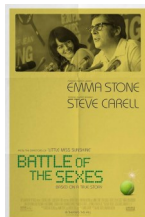

MASSAGE THERAPY AT WATERGATE



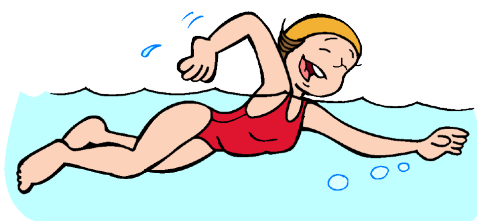
