AR 160 AMENDED TO ADDRESS ASSISTANCE ANIMALS

The Board of Directors recently amended Administrative Resolution 160 (Reasonable Modification/Accommodation). The amended resolution stipulates that if a resident desires an accommodation or modification that involve an Assistance Animal, that resident must submit a formal written request and complete an *Assistance Animal Registration Form*, available at the Resident Services Office and at <http://www.watergateatlandmark.com/other-helpful-documents.html>.

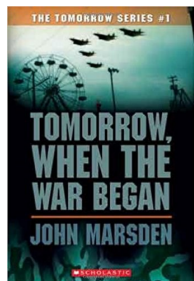
