BICYCLE REGISTRATION

Residents, please be reminded of the need to obtain up-to-date registration decals for all bicycles stored in the garage racks or parking spaces. Bicycles must have a green decal that states, “EXP. Jan 31, 2019.”

As per Association Bylaws, unidentified bicycles on WAL property will be removed, stored for 30 days and then disposed of as necessary. Patrol Services will begin culling racks on April 1. If you haven’t done so already, protect your bike by obtaining a free up-to-date bicycle decal at the Resident Services Office ASAP!

PACKAGE DELIVERY SAFETY TIPS

There has been a recent increase in packages being tampered with or stolen from the front of unit doors. To minimize the risk of having your package tampered with or stolen, below are suggested safety tips for those expecting packages:



Always retrieve packages as soon as they arrive. Use a tracking service to see when your package is scheduled for delivery. If you aren’t going to be home to retrieve a package:

- Send the package to the residence of a trusted neighbor or friend whom you know will be home.
- Ask the package delivery company to hold the package.
- Request that your package is marked “signature required.”
- Have the items shipped to the nearest store for “in-store pickup.”
- Have your packages delivered to you at work, or
- Fill out an authorization form requesting that the package be delivered to the Resident Services Office.
