Please be reminded of the need to obtain up-to-date registration decals for all bicycles stored in the garage racks or parking spaces. Bicycles must have a green decal that states, "EXP. Jan 31, 2019."

As per Association Bylaws, bicycles that do not display current WAL registration decals will be removed, stored for 30 days and then disposed of as necessary. Patrol Services will begin culling racks on April 1. If you haven't done so already, protect your bike! Free 2018 bicycle decals are available at the Registration Services Office.

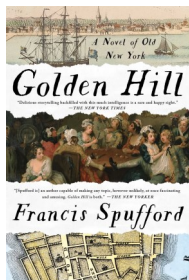
