Please help us avoid parking congestion in the outdoor lots by **moving your vehicle out of the garage by 8 a.m. on the day your garage level is scheduled to be cleaned rather than moving it the night before.** Vehicles may return to the garage after 5 p.m. the same day or earlier if the work is complete.

Overnight visitor parking will not be permitted during this period. Any vehicle displaying a paper visitor parking permit or a guest decal pass **must be offsite** no later than 9 p.m. Sunday, April 14 through Thursday, April 18. This notice includes guests parked in garage parking spaces.

ATTENTION ALL RESIDENTS: CITY ROUTINE WATER FLUSHING BEGINS NEXT WEEK

VA American Water will begin routine flushing its water distribution system in your area between Monday, April 15 and Friday, April 26 from 8 a.m. – 4 p.m. to ensure high-quality water service for all of Alexandria. Flushing also assists in fire hydrant maintenance. When crews work in our area, you may notice reduced pressure or discolored water. If your water is discolored, wait until it runs clear before using. This should typically take only a few minutes.
