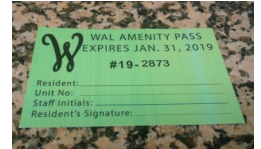

ARE YOUR IDS AND AMENITY PASSES UP-TO-DATE?



Resident identification cards should have a GREEN sticker reading "expires Jan. 31, 2019." Management has informed lifeguards to no longer admit residents with outdated IDs/ Amenity Passes to the pools. If your WAL Amenity Pass or ID is not updated, you will need to stop by the Resident Services Desk during office hours to complete the re-registration process.

MESSAGE FROM VA AMERICAN WATER

Virginia American Water will begin routine flushing of the water distribution system in the Alexandria area during the week of Monday, April 16. Flushing is conducted to ensure high-quality water service and for the monitoring and maintenance of fire hydrants. When crews are working in the Watergate area, you may notice reduced pressure or discolored water. If water is discolored, let it run until it runs clear before using. This should only take a few minutes.

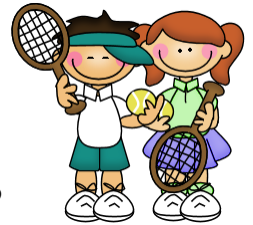
SHUTTLE TRIP: PENNSYLVANIA DUTCH FARMERS MARKET
