## ATTENTION ALL RESIDENTS: CITY WATER FLUSHING ROUTINE BEGINS MONDAY!

VA American Water will begin routine flushing its water distribution system in our area between Monday, April 26 and Friday, May 7, from 8 a.m. – 4 p.m. to ensure high-quality water service for all of Alexandria. Flushing also assists in fire hydrant maintenance. When crews work in our area, you may notice reduced pressure or discolored water. If your water is discolored, wait until it runs clear before using. This typically takes only a few minutes. 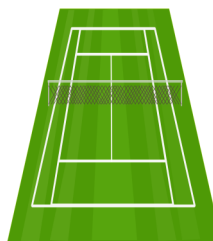

## FREE PICKLEBALL LESSONS AT THE RACQUET CLUB

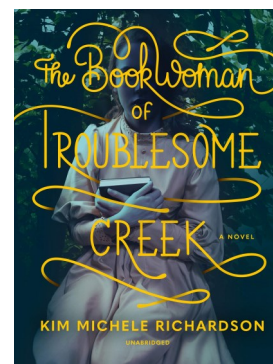
