REMINDER: BUILDING ACCESS

Patrol Services has received notice that the garage doors leading into the service elevator foyers are being propped open. Leaving doors open interferes with the controlled access that is a major reason many residents choose a community like Watergate at Landmark. Put safety first: NEVER prop open any building doors and please alert your contractors to be mindful of this as well.

DURING THE WEEK OF APRIL 30TH

ALL PARKING GARAGE FLOORS WILL BE PROFESSIONALLY CLEANED.

- All vehicles and bicycles in parking spaces must be removed from the level that is scheduled to be cleaned by 8:00 AM. They can return after 5:00 PM the same day or earlier if the work is complete.
- Please help us avoid parking issues in the surface lots. Move out of the garage by 8:00 AM the morning of the cleaning instead of the moving out the night before. Please make sure to return your car to its indoor space after the floors are clean.
- To help alleviate some of the strain; any vehicle displaying a visitor parking permit must be off site by no later than 9:00 PM, Monday, April 30th through Thursday, May 3, 2018.

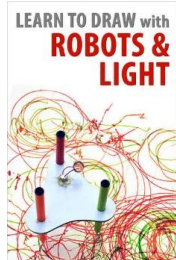
