did not receive one AND you re-registered, please email or call Resident Services to request one.

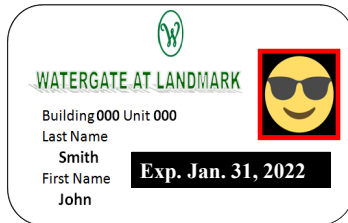
Without an updated ID, you will be refused admission to amenities such as the Outdoor Pool.

SHUTTLE BUS RULES

As a reminder, please be sure you adhere to the following rules from Fleet Transportation when riding our Shuttle Bus:

1. Wear your mask properly (covering your nose, mouth and chin) at all times while on this bus.
2. No standing while the bus is in motion.
3. Sit in the seat facing forward, not leaning against the bus window area with feet obstructing the aisle.

After a warning, the driver may recommend you be restricted from riding the shuttle for a certain timeframe. Thanks in advance for cooperating!

RECYCLING AT WAL

Don't forget to follow the posted signs in the trash area to make sure you place the correct items in the recycling areas or trash chutes. Rinse all containers thoroughly and place them in the correct bin. Small cardboard boxes (shoe box size and under), as well as paper may be placed on the wire wall racks. Garbage should be tightly secured in plastic bags and deposited directly into the chute. Leaving bags on the floor or in the hallways present both health and safety hazards. Thanks for your compliance and continuing to make sure our community is both clean and green!
