## RECEIVING PACKAGES DURING COVID-19

It is recommended you retrieve packages as soon as they arrive. Also, you may want to:



- Request the delivery company to hold the package until you or a designee pick it up.
- Choose to have your package marked as "signature required."
- Some stores have an order online and pick it up in-store or curbside pick-up options.

Please do not have your packages forwarded to Resident Services until the state of emergency has been lifted. An announcement will be made when normal operations resume.



### SCOOTER RULES

The preferred method for scooter and bicycle transportation is in the service elevator. However, bicycles and scooters **are allowed** in the passenger elevators so long as they are walked, not ridden, into them.

The use of any wheeled recre-

ational equipment, including scooters, hover boards, and roller skates or roller blades, is prohibited within all interior common areas such as lobbies and hallways. These items are also not allowed to be used on the sidewalks, stairways, railings and ramps as well as on the landscaped and lawn areas. Such items may be carried in these areas provided they are not used. Garages may not be used for recreational purposes.

You can now come to the office to get your WAL ID an phtoto taken if you moved in during the pandemic. Aleternatively, you can email a head shot to the Move Coor-



### REPUBLICAN PRIMARY VOTING

Tuesday, June 23 • 6 a.m. – 7 p.m. Polling Site: Tucker School, 435 Ferdinand Day Drive



For the Republican Primary for U.S. Senate on June 23, 2020 only, the City will only have six voting locations. This is due to the lack of availability of many typical polling places as a result of COVID-19. Registered voters may choose to cast their ballot at Tucker Elementary School or vote in-person absentee (which is strongly encouraged due to COVID-19). Photo ID is required to vote in-person absentee or at the consolidated voting location.

### By-Mail Absentee

If you would like to receive an absentee ballot by mail, you may apply online, vote.elections.virginia.gov or download a paper application from <a href="https://www.alexandriava.gov/elections/info/default.aspx?id=1720">https://www.alexandriava.gov/elections/info/default.aspx?id=1720</a>. The deadline to apply for an absentee ballot by mail is 5 p.m. on Tuesday, June 16.

### In-Person Absentee

Office hours are Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. for in-person absentee voting. You may do so at the Alexandria Voter Registration Office, 132 North Royal Street. The deadline to vote in-person absentee is 5 p.m. on Saturday, June 20. If a voter chooses to cast an absentee ballot in person, the voter will be asked to remain in their vehicle or outside the office and call the office at 703.746.4050 to begin curbside absentee voting.
