- 3. Sit in the seat facing forward, not leaning against the bus window area with feet obstructing the aisle.


After a warning, the driver may recommend you be restricted from riding the shuttle for a certain timeframe. Thanks in advance for cooperating!

If you find such unwanted "visitors" in your unit, please let Watergate staff know immediately by calling 703-370-7000. Condo dues support a technician's treatment of most common household pests and Watergate will send a technician in to diagnose and in some cases, provide treatment for such.

Alerting Watergate Management of a potential issue is crucial, as it assures Watergate has a complete picture of the scope of an issue and can strategize properly to contain it. Per Watergate's contractor Eagle Pest Services, "It is critical to the success of this program that Watergate Residents not use aerosol foggers or any other over-the-counter pest control products (such as Raid, etc.) in their unit as these treatments tend to simply move the pests to your neighbor, rather than eradicate them."

POOL WEATHER **FACTORS**

According to the National Lightning Safety Institute, at the first sound of thunder or sighting of lightning, all



persons will be cleared from the pool and decks, which will remain clear for at least 30 minutes. If thunder or lightning persists, the pool will remain closed for 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder or sighting of lightning.

However, another factor to consider is the sky's appearance. Unless evident signs of clearing exist, the storm has not officially "ended". The pool will reopen when evidence of clearing is present and danger from lightning no longer exists. When the pool closes for thunder or lightning-related issues, ALL patrons will be asked to leave the facility until it is reopened. This applies to the Outdoor and Indoor Pools.
