Elementary School if they are unable to vote inperson absentee (which is strongly encouraged due to COVID-19). Photo ID is required to vote in-person absentee or at the consolidated voting location.

#### Bv-Mail Absentee

Please do not forget to mail your ballot so it arrives at the Voter Registration Office for Alexandria (132 North Royal Street, Alexandria VA) no later than 7 p.m. on Tuesday, June 23, 2020. Applications are no longer available for the June 23, 2020 primary, as the deadline to apply was on June 16, 2020.

#### In-Person Absentee

Office hours are Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. for in-person absentee voting at the Alexandria Voter Registration Office. The deadline to vote in-person absentee is 5 p.m. on **Saturday, June 20.** If a voter chooses to cast an absentee ballot in person, the voter will be asked to remain inside the vehicle or outside the office. 
