This online database allows you to add and remove visitors as well as set start and expiration dates for their designation as visitors. Once updated, your registered guests should inform Patrol Services that they are "on the Visitor List" to optimize the entry process.

Dept. is investigating a string of thefts from vehicles that recently occurred in the City's West End area. Anyone with information or video of these break-ins should call the APD's non-emergency number at 703-746-4444.

While you cannot always prevent a vehicle break -in, you can take steps to minimize the risk of becoming the victim of one.

- Always lock your vehicle.
- Never leave anything of value in your vehicle, including wallets, keys, money, laptops and tablets, cell phones, jewelry, or weapons.
- Avoid leaving your vehicle parked in one place for an extended period.
- Be aware of your surroundings. If you "See Something, Say Something."


