## IF YOU SEE SOMETHING...



The Alexandria Police Dept. is investigating a string of thefts from vehicles that recently occurred in the City's West End area. Anyone with information or video of these break-ins should call the APD's non-emergency number at 703-746-4444.

While you cannot always prevent a vehicle break-in, you can take steps to minimize the risk of becoming the victim of one.

- Always lock your vehicle.
- Never leave anything of value in your vehicle, including wallets, keys, money, laptops and tablets, cell phones, jewelry, or weapons.
- Avoid leaving your vehicle parked in one place for an extended period.
- Be aware of your surroundings. If you "See Something, Say Something."

Call 911 or the APD's non-emergency number to report any suspicious behavior.

## YOUTH TENNIS TIME

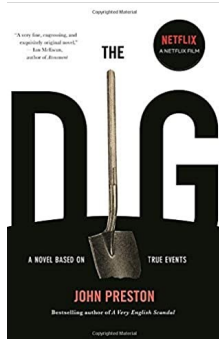
