As a reminder, every resident over the age of one year must have a VALID ID card (with the RED "Expires Jan. 31, 2020" sticker) to use the Indoor or Outdoor Pool. No more than six guests per unit are allowed in the pool at any time with the proper passes. Residents must accompany all guests to the pool. A one-day pass sells for \$5 each.

RECYCLING AT WAL



Don't forget to follow the posted signs in the trash area to make sure you place the correct items in the recycling areas or trash chutes. Rinse all containers thoroughly and place them in the correct bin. Small cardboard boxes (shoe box size and under), as well as paper may be placed on the wire wall racks. Garbage should be tightly secured in plastic bags and deposited directly into the chute. Leaving bags on the floor or in the hallways present both health and safety hazards. Thanks for your compliance and continuing to make sure our community is both clean and green!

PICK UP AFTER YOUR PET!
