### TRASH CHUTE CLEANING NEXT WEEK

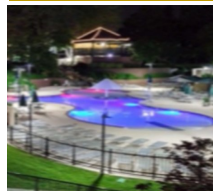

### KEEPING IT GREEN: RECYCLING AT WAL

WAL encourages residents to continue to participate in its single-stream recycling program. Please follow the posted signs in the Trash Room to make sure you dispose of or recycle items properly.

Small cardboard boxes (shoe box size and under), along with paper may be placed neatly on the wire wall racks. Rinse all containers thoroughly and place them in the designated recycling bin. Some may choose to take their cleaned glass to the closest Purple Bin (located near Landmark Towers and Alley Cat Restaurant at the corners of South Whiting St. and Tower Ct.). It is less than one mile away from WAL. This purple bin is managed by local government.

Garbage should be tightly secured in plastic bags and deposited directly into the chute. Leaving bags on the floor or in the hallways present both health and safety hazards. Thanks for your compliance and continuing to make sure our community stays clean and green!

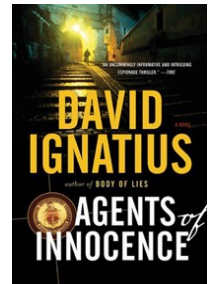
