From Friday, August 7, at 12:01 a.m. through Sunday, August 9, 2020 at 11:59 p.m., you can buy school supplies, clothing and footwear tax free throughout VA. Hurricane/emergency preparedness items, certain Energy StarTM appliances, and WaterSenseTM products purchased for personal or noncommercial use qualify as well. All items must fall under the acceptable items list posted on tax.virginia.gov/virginia-sales-tax-holiday.

BROKEN GATE OPENER?

Vehicles displaying a valid WAL Resident parking decal whose VACD is not working properly may NOT enter through the



automatic Front and Back Gate Resident lanes. Those vehicles must use the Front Gate Visitor lane until the matter is resolved. You can get a VACD gate opener for your vehicle at the Resident Services Office. Violations will be reported.

CARDBOARD BOX DISPOSAL

This is a reminder from Environmental Services to please break down large cardboard boxes and take them to the Loading Dock. Boxes that are the size of a shoe box or smaller can be left in tact on the trash room shelves. Thank you!

GAZEBO USE REMINDERS

To reserve gazebos for private events, residents must fill out a Reservation Request form

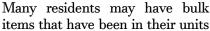


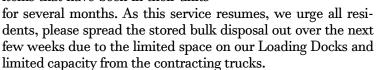
and present payment and security deposit to the Activities Office at least 48 hours in advance. A COVID-19 waiver must also be completed and on file prior to using the gazebo.

Unreserved gazebos as of 8 a.m. on any given day may be claimed for use on a first-come, first-served basis by contacting Patrol Services and obtaining approval. Residents must clean up the gazebo after use and notify Patrol Services for checkout upon completion. Any damages to the structure, furnishings or equipment, as well as an after-use condition that requires extensive cleaning will be billed to the last-known user.

BULK DISPOSAL RESUMES

Our trash contractor, American Disposal Services, has resumed bulk trash collection through the subcontractor, Haulin' Trash Company. Bulk collection days are Mondays, Thursdays and Saturdays.





- Do not put large items including sofas and mattresses on the Loading Dock until the night before the scheduled pick up day.
- Residents are responsible for the disposal of toilets, cabinets, refrigerators, glass doors, windows, carpet and padding.
- Contractors and Appliance/Furniture Delivery services are NOT permitted to use bulk collection. Owners are responsible for their contractors and delivery services.
- Paint, electronics, batteries (other than Alkaline) and all other items considered hazardous to the environment may not be disposed of at Watergate. Take these items to an outside disposal facility.
- There are surveillance cameras located at the Loading Docks, garage areas and inside elevators. Violators will be charged for disposal costs.



HAVE STUFF THAT CAN'T GO INTO BULK OR REGULAR TRASH COLLECTIONS?

The following items are NOT ACCEPTABLE for collection:

- Ammunition/Explosives: Call the Police Department's nonemergency number for disposal at 703-838-4444.
- Construction/Building Materials (includes asphalt, brick, cement, ceramic, cinder block, concrete, drywall, marble, porcelain, and slate): To recycle the materials, use Metropolitan Washington Council of Government (MWCOG) Builder's Recycling Guide for local recycling facilities for a specific material. These materials can also be brought to local solid waste disposal facilities.
- Radioactive/Biological Materials: Contact a private disposal company, e.g.: Clean Harbors, 540-977-3181; Clean Venture, Inc., 757-543-0185 or Potomac Environmental, 804-288-5043.
- Rocks, Dirt, & Sand: Use MWCOG Builder's Recycling Guide for local recycling facilities for a specific material. These materials can also be brought to local solid waste disposal facilities.
- Thermometers and Thermostats (Containing mercury): Take to the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Site.

Materials NOT accepted as trash are as follows: stumps, rocks, dirt, sand, pressurized cylinders or tanks, metal items*, construction/building debris, hazardous waste, ammunition/explosives, regulated medical waste and radioactive/geological materials.

REFRIGERATORS AND DEHUMIDIFIERS NO LONGER ACCEPTED FOR DISPOSAL

Appliances that contain a refrigerant are no longer accepted for disposal as scrap metal at the Covanta Waste to Energy facility, located on Eisenhower Ave. Visit alexandriava.gov/Recycle for disposal instructions.

*Alexandria residents can drop off small amounts of trash and debris, as well as, metal items for recycling once a week, (limit 500 pounds) free-of-charge at Covanta. Upon arrival, check in at the scale house for instructions.
