INDOOR POOL CLOSURE

Our Indoor Pool will close from **Monday, August 13 through Friday, August 24** for annual maintenance. We will post any schedule updates. We encourage you to use our outdoor pool.

WEATHER CLOSINGS AT THE POOLS

WAL has great indoor and outdoor pools, yet unexpected closures occur at times due to inclement weather. Our contracted lifeguards follow the National Lightning Safety Institute's recommendations of clearing all patrons from the water and the pool deck at the first observance of thunder or lightning and not allowing re-entry until **30 minutes** after the thunder or lightning stops. Clearing the pool also occurs when the bottom of the pool is not clearly seen, as in cases of fog, hail, or heavy rain. The area supervisor may close the pool when the air is cooler than 69°F to reduce the risk of hypothermia for WAL residents and guests.

PLANNED POWER OUTAGE

Power will be shut off on the days and times listed below for your building for switch gear maintenance. Emergency generators will provide power to one elevator, emergency hallway lighting and water pumps. All units will not have power or air conditioning. Refrigerators should be kept closed for the day. Residents with special electrical needs should plan accordingly should alternative arrangements be needed.

- Superior brass crimp coupling

PACKAGE DELIVERY



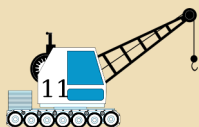
