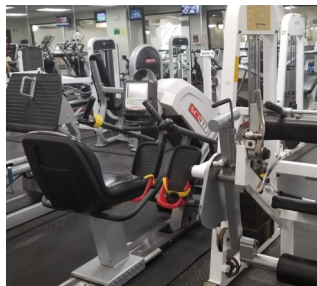
CAR VACUUM AND AIR MACHINE

The air and vacuum machine is conveniently located in the parking lot at the Racquet Club. It accepts quarters and credit card purchases. Owned and operated by Air Tel Systems, it costs \$1.50 for 3 minutes of air and \$2.00 for 4 minutes of vacuuming. The Association receives 25% of the income after the first \$85.00 that the combined machines earn each month. The contractor can monitor the machines remotely to ensure they are operating.

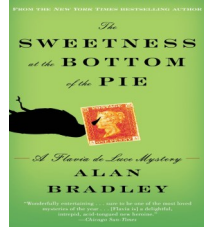

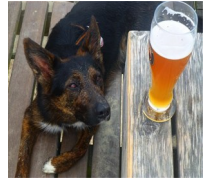
