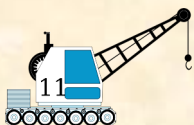
School Board Candidates • 3 – 5 p.m.

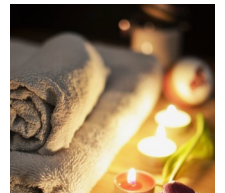
