FREE FLU SHOT CLINIC

The Alexandria Health Department will host a walk-up only clinic on



Saturday, October 3, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., at Francis C. Hammond Middle School (4646 Seminary Road) with support from the City of Alexandria. Parking will be available. The walk-up location will be open to adults and children ages 6 months and up.

Participants must wear a mask over their nose and mouth at all times and maintain six feet of physical distance from others, except when necessary for flu shot clinic operations. Please do not attend if you are feeling sick, even with mild symptoms. Everyone is encouraged to bring a pen to complete forms and minimize shared materials. Flu shots are available at no cost. Proof of residency or insurance is not required.

CITY MASK MANDATE IN EFFECT

Please be advised that per City Ordinance 5293 masks are now required in public spaces within the City of Alexandria



effective October 1, 2020. Indoor public spaces include all enclosed areas that are not your primary residence or personal vehicle. Masks must cover the mouth and nose. This applies for people ages 10 and older. There are limited exceptions to this standard listed on alexandria.gov/coronavirus. For outside public spaces, the rule of thumb is to have masks where social distancing (6-feet minimum) is not possible between people from different households.
