

### VOTER REGISTRATION ENDS ON TUESDAY!

Voter registration for the 2020 Presidential Election ends on Tuesday, October 13. Submit or update your registration information at https://vote.elections.virginia.gov. Any eligible U.S. citizen 18 years of age or older by Election Day (November 3) may register and vote. To check your registration status, go to <a href="https://vote.elections.virginia.gov">https://vote.elections.virginia.gov</a> or call the Alexandria Voter Registration Office at 703-746-4050.

### DON'T FORGET YOUR MASK!

Please be advised that per City Ordinance 5293 masks are now required in public spaces within the City of Alexandria effective October 1, 2020. Indoor public spaces include all enclosed areas that are not your primary residence or personal vehicle. Masks must cover the mouth and nose. This applies for people ages 10 and older. There are limited exceptions to this standard listed on alexandria.gov/coronavirus. For outside public spaces, the rule of thumb is to have masks where social distancing (6-feet minimum) is not possible between people from different households.
