MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE & UPDATES

- Preparations for the HVAC/Fascia Project in Bldg. 4 will begin on Monday, October 29 weather permitting.

MOVE CARS FOR PARKING GARAGE CLEANING

Next week, all parking garages will be professionally cleaned according to the following schedule, rain or shine:

- **Mon., October 15: Bldgs. 1 & 2, Top Level Open Garages**
- **Tues., October 16: Bldgs. 1 & 2, B1 Level**
- **Wed., October 17: Bldgs. 3 & 4, Top Level Open Garages**
- **Thurs., October 18: Bldg. 3 – B2 Level & Bldg. 4 – B1 Level**
- **Fri., October 19: Bldg. 1 – B2 Level & Bldg. 3 – B1 Level**



Residents, please help us avoid parking congestion in the outdoor lots by moving your vehicle out of the garage by 8 a.m. on the day your garage level is scheduled to be cleaned rather than moving it the night before. Vehicles may return to the garage after 5 p.m. the same day or earlier if the work is complete.

Overnight visitor parking will not be permitted during this period. Any vehicle displaying a paper visitor parking permit or a guest decal pass must be offsite no later than 9 p.m. Monday, October 15 through Thursday, October 18. This notice includes guests parked in garage parking spaces.
