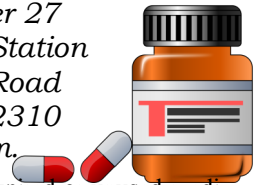
## POLICY REMINDER: VEHICLE DECALS

Please note that parking decals **must be affixed** on the inside of the driver's side of the rear windshield or the driver's side back seat window, **not taped or laid loosely inside the vehicle**. If the vehicle is a convertible or has tinted rear windows, decal can be affixed to the driver's side of the front windshield.

Should your vehicle be observed without a decal present and displayed per policy, Patrol Services will provide a one-time courtesy notice. Subsequent violations may result in immobilizing and/or towing vehicles offsite without further notice.

## 2018 GENERAL ELECTION

Did you know that in Virginia you can vote absentee in advance? Look at the chart to see what options work best for you. The deadline to request an absentee ballot by mail is 5 p.m. on October 30. Please call 703-746-4050 if you need assistance with obtaining a ballot.

Need a ride on Election Day (November 6)? In between the shuttle runs, the Shuttle Bus will drop off and pick up residents at South Port Apartments (6112 Edsall Road) which is the designated polling place for Watergate at Landmark residents. Don't forget your photo ID, as it's required to vote in Virginia. Acceptable forms include VA driver's license, VA DMV-issued photo ID, US passport, employer-issued photo ID, and a student photo ID issued by a VA school, college or university. Don't have one? 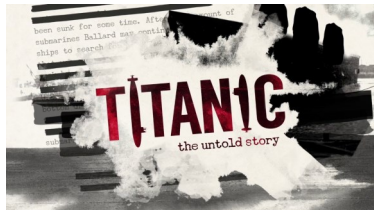
