ELECTION DAY 2018 - TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6

Need a ride on Election Day (November 6)? In between the shuttle stops, the Shuttle Bus will drop off and pick up residents at South Port Apartments (6112 Edsall Road) which is the designated polling place for Watergate at Landmark residents. Poll hours are from 6 a.m. – 7 p.m. You must be in line by 7 p.m. in order to participate in this year's election.

If you are out and about on that day, the Office of Voter Registration also offers "Curb-side" voting, where someone can drive the senior to the office on Election Day. Alternatively, the driver can go into the office and ask an election official to bring a ballot to the senior in the car to complete. For details, go to alexandriava.gov/elections or call 703-746-4050.

Don't forget your photo ID, as it's required to vote in Virginia. Acceptable forms include VA driver's license, VA DMV-issued photo ID, US passport, employer-issued photo ID, and a student photo ID issued by a VA school, college or university. Don't have one? Get a free Voter Photo ID at the Office of Voter Registration.

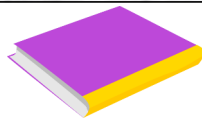
