TRASH ROOM REMINDERS

Each floor has an area dedicated to convenient and safe removal of waste and recyclable materials. Our trash rooms come in handy especially on cold and inclement weather days, and misusing them not only creates an unpleasant environment but also raises the chances of pest control problems. Be sure to advise your children, visitors, housekeepers, contractors, etc. of WAL's trash room rules.

Please tie up all open food containers (with food residue still inside) in a bag and place it directly into the trash chutes. Do not leave it in the recycling bins or on the trash room floor. Place newspaper, magazines, junk mail and other paper on the wall-mounted wire shelves for recycling. Rinse aluminum cans, glass bottles and jars, metal cans and plastic beverage containers and place them in the plastic recycling bins. Break down boxes larger than a shoe box and take to the loading docks.
