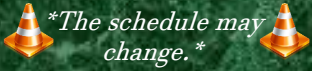

PACKAGE DELIVERY SAFETY TIPS

To minimize the risk of having your package tampered with or stolen, it is suggested that you retrieve packages as soon as they arrive. Many companies offer tracking services to view your package's scheduled delivery time.

If you aren't going to be home to retrieve a package, consider using one of the tips below:

- Send the package to a trusted designee whom you know will be present when it arrives.
- Request the delivery company to hold the package.
- Request your package be marked as "signature required."
- Some stores allow you to order from them and pick it up in-store.
- Receive packages at work while you are there.
- Fill out an authorization form requesting the package be delivered to Resident Services. Packages must weigh no more than 20 pounds and be no larger than 12" x 18" x 24".



STRANGERS AT THE DOOR?

The person waiting at your building's entrance might look harmless, but looks can be deceiving. Most of us don't want to be rude, but as difficult as it may be to refrain from holding a door, every resident is responsible for the security of their building and must be firm about keeping strangers out. If you are asked to buzz in someone you don't know, simply advise them to contact the person they are visiting. If you feel threatened or are harassed, call Patrol Services immediately at 703-370-2674.
