## TRASH DISPOSAL

## SEASONAL DÉCOR REMINDERS

'Tis the season! Seasonal door decorations are permitted without the need to submit an application as long as they meet the following criteria per PR 102:

- Décor must be only on the door and attached in a way that does not damage its finish.
- Decorations should not unduly protrude into the hallway.
- The decorations do not make any sound.
- Decoration must be seasonal or celebratory in nature and may not be combustible nor include overtly political messages, partisan endorsements or business advertisements.
- Decoration size cannot exceed 24" x 24".

Also as a reminder, no sign of any character shall be posted or displayed in public view from any condominium unit as well as upon or in any common element or limited common element without the prior written consent of the Covenants Committee.
