The Management and Resident Services Offices will close today, December 7, from 2 – 5 p.m. for the employee holiday party. Offices reopen at 5 p.m.

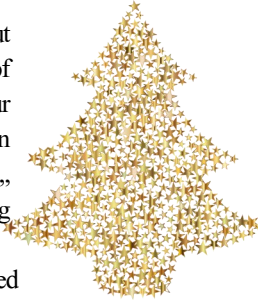


## WHO TO CALL WHEN WAL OFFICES CLOSE

If you have an after-hours maintenance emergency (i.e. water leak) in your unit, call Patrol Services at 703-370-2674 for help. You may also call this number for after-hours issues such as spills in the common areas, suspicious activity, etc. Dial 911 in the case of a life-threatening emergency.

## HOLIDAY DÉCOR GUIDELINES

One of the best things about this time of year for many of us is decorating to your heart's content! As you plan and prepare to deck the halls, keep in mind the following rules on seasonal décor.



- \* Seasonal décor is allowed through **Tuesday, January 15, 2019.**
- \* Décor must not emit sounds.
- \* Refrain from using the balcony ceiling to hang decorations. You may decorate other areas of your balcony provided you follow all safety codes.
- \* Decorations on the door must not protrude into the hallway. Seasonal décor is allowed only on your unit's door (not the walls, door frame, etc.).

## GET RE-REGISTERED TODAY!

Bring your vehicle registrations, pet licenses, current WAL IDs, and amenity passes to Resident Services now through January 31, 2019. As of 10 a.m. today, 166 units are re-registered. Beat the last-minute rush!

## HOUSEGUEST PASSES

Any resident who permits a houseguest to occupy the unit while away from home must register the guest's name, permanent address and vehicle information with Resident Services in advance. A houseguest is defined as one who occupies a unit longer than 24 hours. A Houseguest Pass authorizes the guest to use Association amenities without the resident host. Houseguest passes are limited to a 30-day period unless extended by the General Manager.

## LEAVING TOWN? MAIL AND PACKAGE POLICY

As a courtesy, please remember to email Resident Services at [resident@watergateatlandmark.com](mailto:resident@watergateatlandmark.com) if you plan to leave your unit for multiple days for vacation, business, emergencies, etc. Package deliveries should be forwarded to a trusted neighbor, held at your delivery service's office, or redirected to the Resident Services Office if they meet the requirements (20 lbs. or less AND 18" x 12" x 24" or smaller). Residents are solely responsible for such arrangements. For optimal service, a week's advance notice is greatly appreciated.

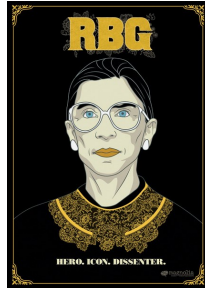

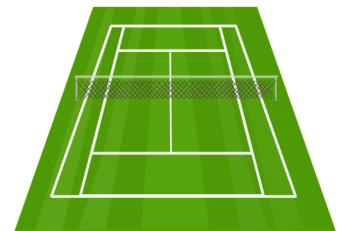
