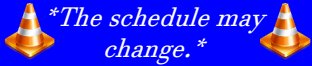

GARAGE FLOOR CLEANING HAPPENING SOON

Parking garage floors will be professionally cleaned per the schedule below, rain or shine:

Fri., April 17	Bldg. 1 – B2 Level Bldg. 3 – B1 Level

Please help us avoid parking congestion in the outdoor lots by moving your vehicle out of the garage by 8 a.m. on the day your garage level is scheduled to be cleaned rather than moving it the night before. Vehicles may return to the garage after 5 p.m. the same day or earlier if the work is complete.

Overnight visitor parking will not be permitted during this period. Any vehicle displaying a paper visitor parking permit or a guest decal pass must be offsite no later than 9 p.m. Monday, April 13 through Thursday, April 16. This notice includes guests parked in garage parking spaces.

BICYCLE REGISTRATION



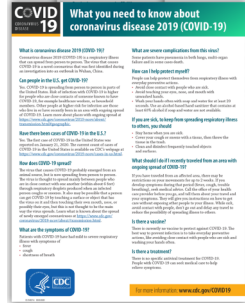
Residents, be sure to obtain current registration decals for all bicycles stored in the garage racks or parking spaces if you did not do so at re-registration. Bicycles must have a yellow decal that states, "EXP. Jan 31, 2021."

As per Association Bylaws, unidentified bicycles on WAL property will be removed, stored for 30 days and then disposed of as necessary. Patrol Services will begin culling racks on April 1. So protect your bike by obtaining an up-to-date bicycle decal at the Resident Services Office!
