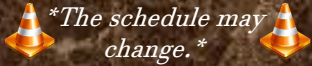

WAITING FOR GROCERY OR FOOD DELIVERIES?

Services like Giant's Peapod, Uber Eats and other food delivery services are admitted by the Front Gate Patrol Services Officer upon confirmation from the resident. Residents may call Patrol Services to grant admittance in advance or the officer will attempt to reach the resident in the event preapproval was not received.



TRASH PICK-UP CHANGES

Please note the following changes due to the pandemic:

- Please do not put discarded furniture, electronics, construction materials, etc. on the Loading Dock.
- Recycling is still available. Please follow the current rules regarding such.
- Cardboard boxes that are broken down may be left neatly in the Loading Dock. This does not include pizza boxes.



HELP "COMBAT" COVID-19

The World Health Organization is advising people to follow five simple steps to help prevent the spread of COVID-19:

- Report issues related to any toilet sounds or leaks to Metro Water at 703-461-3418.
- Consider the benefits of replacing older light bulbs with ones that are more energy efficient.
- Turn off the water, lights and electronics when leaving the room.
- Adjust the thermostat if you are going to be out of the unit and off property for a long time. These steps can help reduce the costs associated with utilities that unit owners pay for in the annual dues.

SHUTTLE SCHEDULE CHANGES



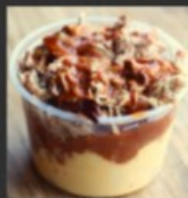
Due to the closure of the Blue Line Metro stop at Van Dorn St., WAL's shuttle will instead go to the King Street Station.
