The Board President will call your name and you will have three minutes to speak. Thereafter, you will need to mute your phone for the remainder of the meeting.

FREE COVID-19 TESTING THIS MONDAY

Monday, May 25 10 a.m. – 6 p.m.

Landmark Mall (5801 Duke St.; enter from Van Dorn St.)
Cora Kelly School (3600 Commonwealth Ave.)

Alexandria Health Dept., the City of Alexandria, and the Virginia Depts. of Health and Emergency Management, are supporting two free COVID-19 community testing events on Monday, May 25. Testing sites will be at Landmark Mall (drive-through and walk-up testing) and Cora Kelly School for Math, Science and Technology (walk-up testing only). Everyone visiting a testing site should wear a cloth face covering or surgical mask, Walk-up participants should wear sunscreen.

Testing is open to anyone over the age of 2, but the primary purpose will be for community members who have not previously been able to access testing. These testing sites will not require doctor referrals, appointments, or identification. Spanish, Arabic, and Amharic translators will be available on-site.

SMOKING AND NON-SMOKING AREAS

INDOOR COMMON ELEMENTS

Smoking is not allowed in or at the following indoor common elements:

- Building hallways, lobbies and garages.
- The WAL Community Center
 - This includes the Terrace Lounge, Indoor Pool, Fitness Center, Card Room, TV Room, Library, Table Tennis Room, Billiards Room, and all restrooms and all connecting hallways between any of these facilities.
- All WAL offices, meeting rooms and storage areas
- Anywhere inside of the WAL Racquet Club
- All commercial areas (convenience store/café, salon, etc.)

Note, any contractor doing business with the Association and working in a private unit is prohibited from smoking in that unit.

OUTDOOR COMMON ELEMENTS

Smoking is not allowed at the following outdoor common elements:

- The Outdoor Pool, Lower Terrace and all sidewalks, stairwells and grassy areas in between these areas (Smoking is permitted on the Upper Terrace).
- The outdoor tennis courts and the multi-purpose area.
- The playground and adjacent benches.
- The loading docks – indoor and outdoor areas.
- Rooftop observation deck.
