LIFEGUARD TRAINING

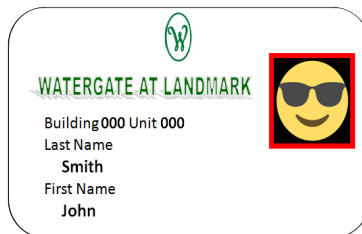
Have you seen people in the Outdoor Pool? Well, American Pools is training its lifeguards here through Friday, June 26, 2020.

REPUBLICAN PRIMARY VOTING

Tuesday, June 23 • 6 a.m. – 7 p.m.
Polling Site: Tucker School
435 Ferdinand Day Drive

For the Republican Primary for U.S. Senate on June 23, 2020, the City will have six voting locations. Registered voters living at WAL may cast their ballot at Tucker Elementary School if they are unable to vote in-person absentee (which is strongly encouraged due to COVID-19). Photo ID is required to vote in-person absentee or at the consolidated voting location.



By-Mail Absentee

Please do not forget to mail your ballot so it arrives at the Voter Registration Office for Alexandria (132 North Royal Street, Alexandria VA) no later than 7 p.m. on Tuesday, June 23, 2020. Applications are no longer available for the June 23, 2020 primary, as the deadline to apply was on June 16, 2020.

In-Person Absentee

Office hours are Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. for in-person absentee voting at the Alexandria Voter Registration Office. **The deadline to vote in-person absentee is 5 p.m. on Saturday, June 20.** If a voter chooses to cast an absentee ballot in person, the voter will be asked to remain inside the vehicle or outside the office. FSRCONNECT VISITORS LIST

Do you have long-term guests or contractors? For your convenience, you can use FirstService's "Visitor List" function instead of calling Resident Services each time your visitors arrive! This online database allows you to add and remove visitors as well as set start and expiration dates for their designation as visitors. **Once updated, registered guests should inform Patrol Services that they are on the Visitor List to optimize the entry process.**
