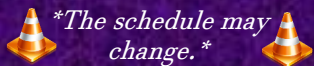

## PHONE SCAM ALERT



The Alexandria Police Department is aware of a telephone scam that targets people and asks them to provide money to remove criminal charges.

Individuals have reported receiving phone calls from someone falsely using the identity of an Alexandria sworn police employee. In the scam, the caller uses the name of a sworn officer, and advises that there are warrants for the subject's arrest. The caller provides instructions on how to pay a large sum of money, then passes the victim on to another person to explain a "surety voucher."

The Alexandria Police Department does not make such calls and will never request money over the phone. If you receive such a call, immediately hang up. Do not provide the caller with any information and do not answer any questions.

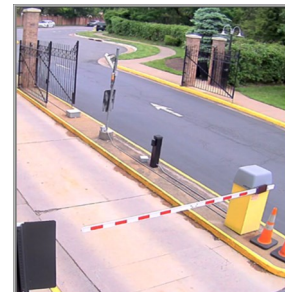

## BROKEN GATE OPENER?

Vehicles displaying a valid WAL Resident parking decal whose VACD is not working properly may NOT enter through the automatic Front and Back Gate Resident lanes. ## CHECK YOUR HAND SANITIZER



The U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA) continues to find issues with certain hand sanitizer products. FDA test results show certain hand sanitizers have concerning low levels of ethyl alcohol or isopropyl alcohol, the active ingredients in hand sanitizer products. The agency urges consumers not to use these subpotent products and has expanded its [list](#) to include subpotent hand sanitizers, in addition to hand sanitizers that are or may be contaminated with methanol.

FDA continues to add certain hand sanitizers to an import alert to stop these products from legally entering the U.S.

FDA reminds consumers to wash their hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating, and after coughing, sneezing or blowing one's nose. If soap and water are not readily available, the [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention](#) (CDC) recommend consumers use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60 percent ethanol (also referred to as ethyl alcohol). Additionally, FDA reminds consumers that no drugs, including hand sanitizers, are approved to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

FDA encourages people to report adverse events or quality problems experienced with the use of hand sanitizers to FDA's MedWatch Adverse Event Reporting Program. ## SMART 911

The free Smart911 service allows individuals and businesses to create online safety profiles with home, workplace and mobile phone numbers, along with additional information that would be valuable to dispatchers and first responders during an emergency. This information often includes home or work addresses, details about medical conditions, hazardous materials on the property, pets, and emergency contacts. Users are prompted to update their safety profiles every six months to ensure their information remains accurate. Smart profiles are kept confidential and secure and are only available to trained dispatchers in participating 911 centers across the country.
