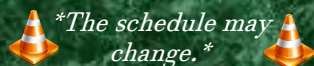

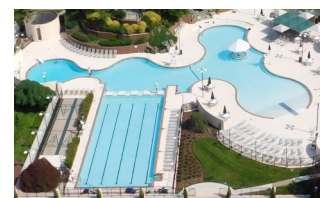
## SMART 911

The free Smart911 service allows individuals and businesses to create online safety profiles with home, workplace and mobile phone numbers, along with additional information that would be valuable to dispatchers and first responders during an emergency. This information often includes home or work addresses, details about medical conditions, hazardous materials on the property, pets, and emergency contacts. Users are prompted to update their safety profiles every six months to ensure their information remains accurate. Smart profiles are kept confidential and secure and are only available to trained dispatchers in participating 911 centers across the country. ## OUTDOOR POOL USE DURING COVID-19



There are two more weeks of Outdoor Pool season left, as weekday operations cease after Labor Day. Keep the following in mind when visiting the pool facilities here at WAL:

- Entire pool is open for diving, exercise, free swim or instruction.
- Only three people are permitted in diving area with 10-foot distancing.
- The outdoor spa, foot wash river and the spray pad are closed.
- Pool (not deck) must close every 45 minutes for disinfection of touch surfaces.
- There is a maximum of 250 residents allowed at one time whether the persons are in the pool or on the deck.
- Maintain at least 10 feet of physical distance between anyone who is not from the same household.
- Face coverings are recommended when not able to maintain social distancing.
- There is a three person maximum per lane with 10-foot distancing between swimmers in the outdoor lap lane.
- No guests are allowed at this time.

## INDOOR POOL USE DURING COVID-19

- Entire pool is open.
- Spa and saunas are closed.
- Pool (not deck) must close every 45 minutes for disinfection of touch surfaces.
- No more than 62 residents can be in the facility whether they are in the pool or not.
- While within this facility maintain 10 foot of physical distance between anyone who is not from the same household.
- Face coverings are recommended when not able to maintain social distancing.
- There is a three person maximum per lane with 10-foot distancing between swimmers in the indoor lap lane.
- No guests allowed at this time.

## WATERGATE RESTAURANT HAS ITS LIQUOR LICENSE

There are a few changes happening at the Watergate Restaurant and Market:

- The Watergate Restaurant and Market is now licensed to sell beer and wine.
- Delivery to your unit is now available Thursday – Sunday with an order of at least \$25. Credit or debit cards accepted via phone. Checks or cash in exact change accepted upon delivery. Delivery people will not have change.
- Orders will be taken until 8:30 p.m. The Market will remain open until 9 p.m.
- Business hours will be 8 a.m. – 9 p.m. starting Tuesday, September 1, for the entire month.
