ALEXANDRIA HEALTH DEPARTMENT (AHD) HOSTS FREE FLU SHOT CLINICS

The AHD will host two free flu shot clinics this fall with support from the City of Alexandria. Participants must wear a mask over their nose and mouth at all times and maintain six feet of physical distance from others, except when necessary for flu shot clinic operations. Please do not attend if you are feeling sick, even with mild symptoms. Everyone is encouraged to bring a pen to complete forms and minimize shared materials. Flu shots are available at no cost. Proof of residency or insurance is not required.

A drive-through only clinic will occur at T.C. Williams High School (3330 King St.) on **Saturday, September 26, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.**, It's open to people ages 12 and over with a limit of four per vehicle.

A walk-up only clinic will be held on **Saturday, October 3, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.**, at Francis C. Hammond Middle School (4646 Seminary Road). Parking will be available. The walk-up location will be open to adults and children ages 6 months and up.

- Pet Committee members reserve the right to refuse admission to any dog that they deem to be aggressive.
- Assess your dog's personality for compatibility, since many dogs of different breeds and sizes will participate.
- Owners must clean up after their dogs!
